Luke 7: 11

In this gospel Jesus shows us why His compassion and love for us is unmatched. Keenly aware, that a widow who loses her only son is at quite a disadvantage 2000 years ago, He is moved to perform a miracle which left people then and now awestruck. Notice how as God, He is meeting the great crowd at the precise moment they are taking the funeral procession out. Jesus shows His authority by going directly over to the dead man and taking his hand. He will do the same to us at the Last Judgment--if we were faithful to Him. The reason why a crowd was an integral part in the gospel is due to the fact that their response was what Jesus had intended everyone to hear, and in effect bear witness to this: "God has visited his people."
